A Neighborly Recipe:

Cinnamon Bread

1 loaf frozen bread dough
¾ - 1 cup sugar

2 - 4 tsp. Cinnamon
Margarine

Raisins (optional)

Thaw a loaf of frozen bread dough completely, but don't let it begin to rise. Flatten the bread dough into a small rectangle and spread margarine over the entire top. Mix sugar and cinnamon, then spread over the margarine. Sprinkle with raisins if you like them.

(Otherwise, it's great without them, too!)

Starting at the long end, roll up the bread dough. Pinch the ends closed along both the side and the ends. Spray or grease a bread pan and lay the bread in the pan, pinched side up. Let rise and bake as directed on the package.

Take over to your neighbor while it's still warm!!!
